InSite Enterprise Software is designed to improve the control and efficiency of your medication storage, packaging and delivery process. The InSite System improves patient safety, increases accuracy and reduces the time needed to prepare for daily medication passes.

InSite Enterprise Software enables real-time integration with your current pharmacy management system and software. It ensures that stored medications are accessed by the right facility staff, packaged for a specific patient, and tracked at delivery. The software is efficient, easy-to-use, and provides workflow guidance to help prevent medication errors.

InSite Enterprise Software supports the following workflows:

ROUTINE DISPENSE

Allows you to process daily medication orders.

- Orders contain all hours of administration (HOA) medication passes for all residents of the facility.
- Necessary files to run the Per Dose orders are received the day (or evening) before the actual medication pass.

NEW ORDERS

Orders of changed medications for current residents or new orders for newly arriving residents at the facility.

PRN

PRN orders are received by the Workstation from the Pharmacy at least once a day or at any time a change has been made in any patient's PRN medications.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Allows you to dispense future medications for a patient who will be leaving the facility temporarily.

E-KIT

After an E-Kit request has been made by a user with specific permissions for that option, those orders are dispensed by an authorized user. Dispenses are reported electronically to the pharmacy for regulatory and billing compliance. E-Kit is an optional configuration.

USER ADMIN

Application is installed at the location of the Site Administrator (at the central pharmacy and/or the remote facility). Authorized personnel manage and set account privileges for users of the InSite System.

- Dispense medication orders through the Kiosk Workstation
- View and print reports through the Reports application
- Enroll for Fingerprint Security, if required and enabled
- Check in newly filled medication canisters

REPORTS

Provides facilities and pharmacies with the analytical tools to more effectively manage operations and allows for visibility into critical operational data, including site-specific inventory and dispense history.

- Allows quick and easy access to vital information, such as:
 - Dispensing History
 - Inventory Levels
 - Consumption / Utilization trends
 - Regulatory Compliance Data
- Reports include, but are not limited to:
 - Canister Replenishment
 - Dispense
 - Emergency Dispense
 - Expiring Canisters
 - Inventory

- Application is installed on any PC including the Kiosk Workstation at the facility and the InSite Pharmacy System Workstation at the pharmacy.
